Voter Registration Requirements

- Must be 18 Years old on or before the next election date.
- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Must not be under a definitive judgment of mental incompetence.
- Must not be under an order of imprisonment for the conviction of a felony.
- Must reside in the parish in which you wish to register to vote.
